Parliamentary Committees: Reaching out to Canadians

Parliamentarians spend a significant percentage of their time on committee work. It is through the committee process that members of the public are able to participate directly in the legislative process and have a direct influence on Senators and Members of Parliament. At the same time, parliamentary committees are undergoing a period of change: the removal of Parliamentary Secretaries as regular members of House committees, the participation of independent Senators in committees and the rise in popularity of the “town hall-style meeting” for travelling committees have all had an impact on the way committees work and engage with the public. What other trends are shaping the committees’ landscape? This seminar will examine the role parliamentary committees play in the democratic process.
